

## Cookie Policy

The International Yehudi Menuhin Foundation (“IYMF”) uses cookies to help you navigate this Web site more easily. IYMF may use the information that it collects via the cookies on an anonymous basis during your browsing session on this Web site to improve the site content to meet your needs and preferences.

The IYMF takes your privacy and personal data seriously (see our Privacy Policy). Due to a new EU-wide regulation on privacy which comes into force in May 2018, all Web sites in the EU are henceforth required to request your explicit consent to the use or storage of cookies on your computer or mobile devices. This Cookie Policy is therefore designed to inform you about the cookies that we use on this Web site and their purpose.

1. What are cookies

A “cookie” is a small text file that an Internet Web site server installs on your computer or mobile device when you consult a Web site.

The information stored in the cookies of the IYMF Web site is used solely by the IYMF and only when you navigate this Web site.

2. Why we use cookies

Our Web site uses cookies to track individual user preferences in order to improve the user experience, as well as to optimise our Web site.

3. Types of cookies

Although there are different types of cookies defined by function, origin or storage period, the law identifies two main sorts: functional or technically essential cookies (e.g., cookies which remember your login details, guarantee the security of your login details, ensure the uniformity of the appearance of the Web site), and non-functional cookies (e.g., counting the number of visitors to the Web site, recording how visitors use the Web site, improving Web site performance and/or user experience).

Our Web site uses the following cookies:

**Functional cookies**

__stid	Sharethis.com (USA)	Performance cookie that is set as part of the ShareThis service and monitors "click-stream" activity, e.g. web pages viewed, navigation from page to page, time spent on each page etc. It registers a unique ID that identifies your device for return visits. The ShareThis service personally identifies you only if you have separately signed up with ShareThis for a ShareThis account and given them your consent.
